Other Conditions

Entry forms must reach the specified address or be completed online by 5:00pm Friday 19th November. Late entries will be available at Dawn Fraser Pool between 7:00am – 8:30am on the day of the event, at an additional fee.

The pre race briefing will take place at the Dawn Fraser Pool 15 minutes before the start of the swim, at approximately 8:30am. All competitors must attend the briefing.

Entries are restricted to persons who have adequately trained for this event and acceptance of an entry is at the absolute discretion of the organising committee. Entries of young children inexperienced in open water swimming should not be submitted.

Swimmers physical condition is their own responsibility. All participants are encouraged to train for this event and have a medical check up prior to entry.

Persons wearing wetsuits, fins or flotation devices are ineligible for any prizes.

All swimmers must wear a cap. Each swimmer enters the event at their own risk. There are plenty of safety craft and boats patrolling the course, signal them if you need any help. Numbers will be placed on your arm for identification purposes.

It is compulsory to have your name checked off at the completion of your event, even if you did not complete the course.

All decisions of the organising committee will be absolute and final including the right to cancel the race due to weather conditions or other safety considerations.

In the event of cancellation there will be no refund of the entry fee.
